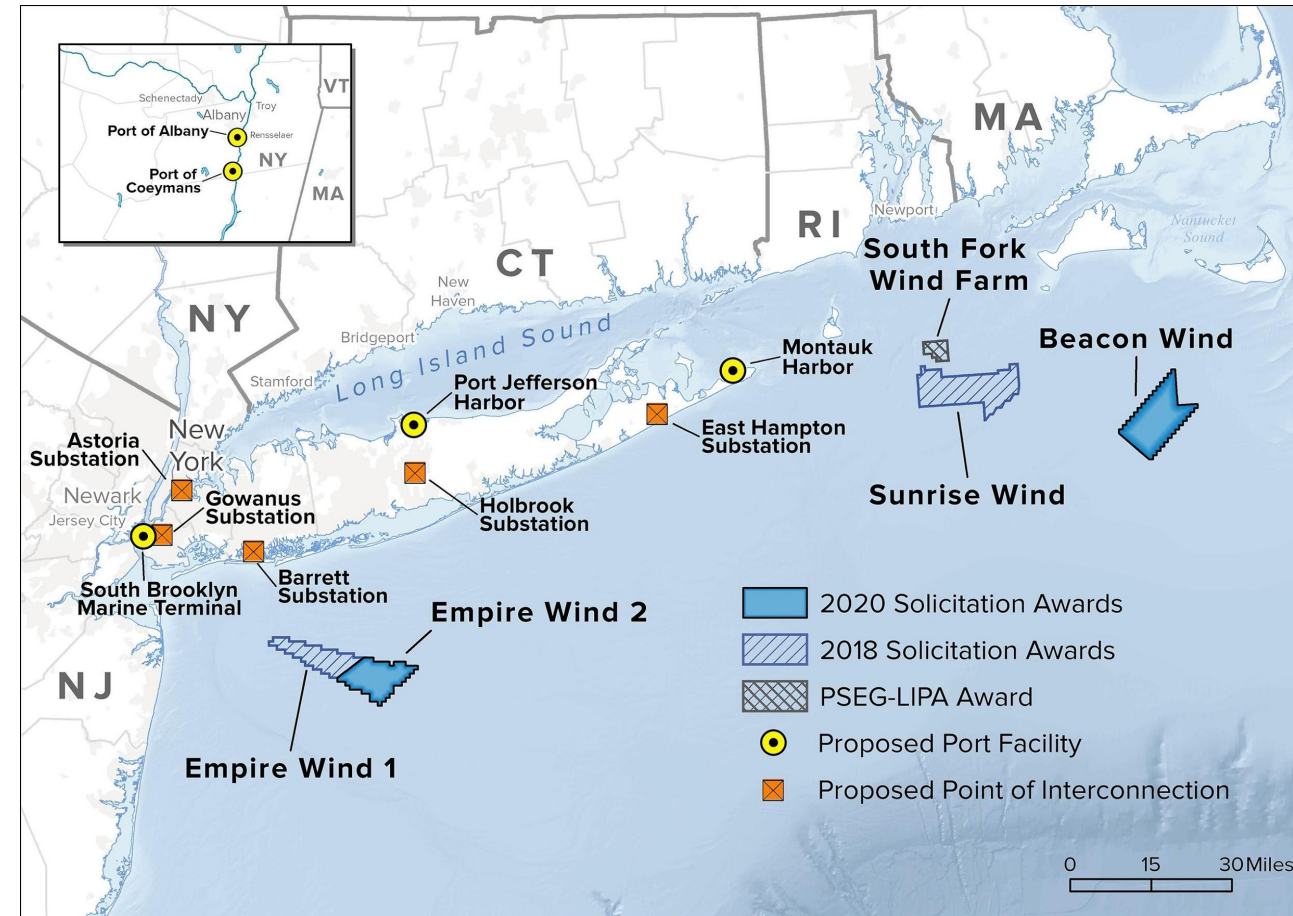
More than 4,300 MW in Active Development

- > Combined economic activity of **\$12.1 billion** in labor, supplies, development, and manufacturing statewide

2022 Milestones:

- > BOEM auctioned **6 new lease areas** in the NY Bight
- > **Joint supply chain effort between BOEM, NY and NJ**
- > Contracts for Empire Wind 2 and Beacon Wind finalized
- > Governor Hochul announced **\$500 million** to support offshore wind supply chain
- > South Fork Wind receives federal approval to **start construction**
