Reading Assignment for Wednesday, August 14, 2019

In law school, you will be introduced to new types of reading, analysis, and thinking, which will take practice to master. Please do not be concerned if you complete the assignment and feel that you do not understand everything. This is perfectly normal! All we ask for now is that you do the assignment carefully, and try your best to understand the material and answer the study questions. We will go over the material in detail in the Academic Skills classes during Orientation.
