Graduation Rate

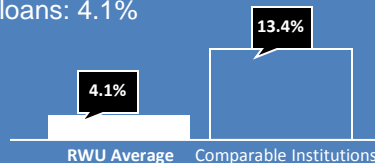
Percentage of full-time undergraduate students who graduate within 6 years: 59%
