


Gulf Oil Spill

Attributable to regulatory failure





Administrative Law

- Enables public interest groups to be "watchdogs"
 - File comments on proposed regulations
 - Take agencies to court if regulations are inadequate











Reality


- Limited public interest participation
- Internal agency resistance to stronger regulation



Limited Public Interest Involvement



- Regulated entities
 - ▼ File many more comments
 - Have many more meetings
- Often no public interest comments
- Result
 - Information asymmetries
 - Capture



Internal Resistance

- Hostile presidential appointees
- Revolving door
- Deep Capture
 - **x** Transference
 - **Conflicts** of interest

Result

- Agency resistance to stronger regulation
- Capture

- Positive Metrics
 - Indicator reports
 - Measuring regulatory progress


